Awards: Award presentations will take place as soon as possible following the races.

Awards for athletes 15 years and younger will be provided by Teck Resources Ltd.

Awards for older athletes will be provided by Omineca Ski Club.

Concession: There will be no concession. However, a bag lunch (sandwich, vegetables, energy ball/granola bars, fresh fruit) will be provided to all racers and volunteers. Racers must pre-order lunch through Zone 4.

Waxing: The Omineca Ski Club Waxing Cabin will be available for waxing.

Outdoor electric plug ins will be available for hot irons.

CCBC Protocol regarding the Use of Fluorinated Waxes

Cross Country BC has adopted a No Fluoro policy for all age categories at all Teck Regional Cup races. For more information, see:

Non-fluoro waxing protocol applies to all ages:

- Structure tools ARE permitted
- Fluorinated grip waxes ARE permitted
- Only identified non-fluoro (NF) glide waxes are permitted

Accommodation: Accommodations are available in the Village of Burns Lake.

Trail pass: Registered racers can use trails for the day of the race. Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. Family and coaches of racers from out of the Burns Lake area can request complimentary trail passes for the day of the race.

Cancellation: There will be no refund for participants who choose to not start their race. If race organizers cancel the race(s) due to unsafe weather conditions, a full refund will be made to participants except for any online processing fees. Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at start time.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. For athletes under 12 years of age, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.
