Trail pass:

Registered racers can use trails on the day of the race. Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. Family and coaches of racers from out of the Burns Lake area can request complimentary trail passes for the day of the race.

Cancellation:

There will be no refunds for participants who choose not to start their race. If race organizers cancel the race(s) due to unsafe weather conditions, participants will receive a full refund, excluding any online processing fees. Races will be cancelled or postponed if the temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at start time.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course, without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. For athletes under 12 years of age, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course, without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.
