Omineca Ski Club Hosts Teck Northern Cup #5

On Sunday, January 18th, the Omineca Ski Club (OSC) hosted Teck Northern Cup #5. A total of 61 racers from the Snow Valley Nordic Ski Club (Kitimat), Bulkley Valley Cross Country Ski Club (Smithers), Omineca Ski Club (Burns Lake), Nechako Nordics (Vanderhoof) and Caledonia Nordic Ski Club (Prince George) enjoyed a fabulous day at the club ski venue. Hosting the race in January we thought our biggest concern would be cold temperatures but it turns out the week before the race there was warm temps & rain! - this diminished our snowpack significantly. Fortunately, the temps lowered enough to allow our trail crew to work their magic, resulting in trails that were 'exceptional', as commented by more than one racer.

The youngest age group (U6) started off the events with a 400m race loop that was lined with Stuffedies to encourage them on their route.

Participants in the U8 – to U16 categories demonstrated ski skills & great sportsmanship during their events.

The Open & Masters skiers rounded off the day by skiing a 10.5km route. We had a wide range of racers in this group: our Open Men racers (Cole & Jesse) had been competing against each other since they were in the U8 category and have many years of experience. For at least one of our Masters it was his very first xc ski race – which he commented was like running but with skis on.
